

## Suggested groupings and order for traditional photographs

	Approximate time required before the ceremony
<b>the Bride</b> relaxed portrait with all bridesmaids with individual bridesmaids	20 minutes
<b>the Groom</b> relaxed portrait with all groomsmen with individual groomsmen	20 minutes
<hr/>	
<b>Complete Bridal Party</b> Bride & Groom all Bridesmaids, all Groomsmen (flower girl and ring-bearer if desired)	Approximate time required after the ceremony  5 minutes
<b>the Girls</b> Bride & Groom with all the Bridesmaids Bride with Maid of Honor	6-10 minutes
<b>the Guys</b> Bride & Groom with all the Groomsmen Groom with Best-man	For each arrangement please allow for 3-4 minutes
<b>Bride's family</b> Bride & Groom with parents with grandparents with parents and grandparents with siblings	10-12 minutes
<b>Groom's family</b> Bride & Groom with parents with grandparents with parents and grandparents with siblings	
<b>Bride &amp; Groom</b>	7 minutes

I suggest, the two of you consider a 'first look', where the two of you see each other *before* the ceremony.

Many of my couples choose to do this, as it makes for some incredible moments. In addition, if your families and bridal party are present, we can accomplish all the photos *before* the ceremony, and you can immediately attend your cocktail hour with your guests. It really only requires that you begin to get ready a few minutes earlier, and gives you time to enjoy your wedding so much more.
